Financial Planning

In order that parents can plan for events coming up that will require some additional funds the following reminder will hopefully help.

- Current Y1 parents need to be aware that in Y2 the children go swimming the cost of this is usually approximately £50-£55 per term, depending on the length of the term and therefore the number of sessions available.
- Current Y2 parents need to be aware that when your child starts school in September as a Y3 their school dinners are no longer government funded and will need payment in advance at the beginning of the half term.
- Current Y2/3 children will have an opportunity to attend the residential trip in March 2019 which is approximately £75.
- Current Y4/5 children will go on their residential visit in November 2018 which costs approximately £325. Payment will be required in advance of the trip during the Autumn term. Children who receive pupil premium funding no longer get a supported place from NYCC so will also require payment to attend.
