Building Blocks for Language <i>Referral-only</i>	8 weekly sessions to help you to see how easy it can be to use and improve your child's language in everyday life. Singing Speech <i>Referral-only</i>	6 weekly sessions to raise children's awareness of the sounds they are using; to encourage children to listen to the sounds in words; to help parents to integrate phonological awareness activities into their everyday routines. Referral via Speech and Language Therapist	Children aged 3-4 years with delayed speech development & parents/carers
Bookstart Corner <i>Referral-only</i>	Home visits with children and parents/carers, to learn how to share books, stories and rhymes with your child in a fun way	Children aged 12 months - 2 years & parents/carers
