This inspection came just four weeks after our Ofsted inspection where it was confirmed that the school provides a good, quality education with an **Outstanding** Early Years Unit.

The Church school inspection goes deeper into the impact that a church school education has on it's pupils and families. Parents said the school was a 'Shining example of a caring and compassionate school'. The report mentions how Governors rigorously measure the impact of the vision statement which is to '**Shine and share your light.**' Leaders prioritise good mental health and wellbeing for everyone, with pastoral support readily available for those who need it. Spiritual growth of pupils occurs naturally through a challenging , crafted curriculum to answer life's big questions. Pupils show exceptional behaviour and are taught about good and bad choices, how to disagree well and seek forgiveness. It was reported that staff go above and beyond what would be expected in order to support the children and families in the school community and beyond.
